Maurine Dickey is known for her two-term service as a Dallas County Commissioner. Prior to her election to the Dallas County Commissioners Court, she served as Chairman of the Parkland Hospital Board of Managers, and she was instrumental in beginning the nonprofit Prostitute Diversion Initiative in partnership with the Dallas Police Department.

Maurine also has a history of serving her community's children. For over six years, Maurine served on and was chair of the Texas Department of Protective & Regulatory Services. She also served as chair of the Dallas County Child Welfare Board and served on the County Juvenile Board. She was a founding member of CPS Community Partners and the Rainbow Room in 1990.

Maurine and Roland Dickey have two sons, and all are graduates of Southern Methodist University. The Dickey family owns Dallas-based Dickey's Barbecue Pit restaurants, a franchised chain of over 500 restaurants nationwide. In connection with the chain, Maurine chairs the Barbecue, Boots & Badges Foundation, which serves members of law enforcement and firefighters.

We are proud to honor Maurine for her long and outstanding service to her community and to its children. Proceeds from this annual event benefit the students of Texans Can seeking a second chance and renewed hope of economic independence. Maurine is passionate about Texans Can because it serves the city's most underserved population.

"These students comprise the most underserved population of kids in Dallas," Maurine says. "Some kids have families, some have no family. Texans Can accepts and meets students where they are.
